



#### Percent of COVID-19 tests that were positive Marion County, September 27 -October 21, 2020






#### Newly Confirmed Cases Marion County, September 27 - October 24, 2020

#### ED Visits with COVID-19 Symptoms Marion County, September 27 - October 27, 2020



1st-time Hospital Admissions for Persons with COVID-19 Positive Lab. Test Marion County, September 27 - October 24, 2020




### Deaths Marion County, September 27 - October 24, 2020




#### New Cases per 100,000 resident Central Indiana Counties, Oct 13 - Oct 27






#### Age Distribution of confirmed COVID-19 cases by month, Marion County, IN, 3/1, -2020-10-21

- No changes to current order:
  - Masks, No Large Gatherings, Socially Distance
- Contact tracing is crucial Please answer your phone, text, or email
- Expanding MCPHD testing to include asymptomatic individuals
- Launching systematic random surveillance program with IU Fairbanks School of Public Health:
  - Determine prevalence in Marion County
  - Supports contact tracing for asymptomatic COVID-19 residents
